the project

The kitchen and family room in this home are combined to make a great space for entertaining and hanging out. The synergy of these two spaces was imperative in the overall design as I envisioned that the homeowners would spend a lot of time in this space.

my look

The selection of stone for the fireplace wall needed to work well with the finishes in the kitchen. A white kitchen feels fresh and uncomplicated. The shaker style cabinetry was elevated by adding a small half inch banding in addition to the traditional shaker look. This created a little more interest and a lot more style. I'm usually not a fan of granite, therefore the slab for the waterfall of the island took me by surprise. The fireplace wall was so monochromatic; the kitchen would have lacked pizzazz with a solid coloured quartz counter top. When I saw this piece of granite, I was sold. It had the movement and depth of marble or quartzite with the durability of granite! The stainless steel backsplash provided a great backdrop for the 'statement' stone that was used on all the counters in the kitchen. Lastly, the three pendants over the island are a nod to the foyer chandelier keeping the design consistent throughout the home.
